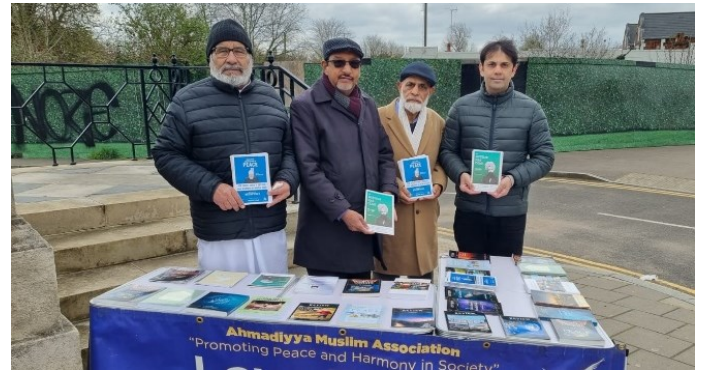

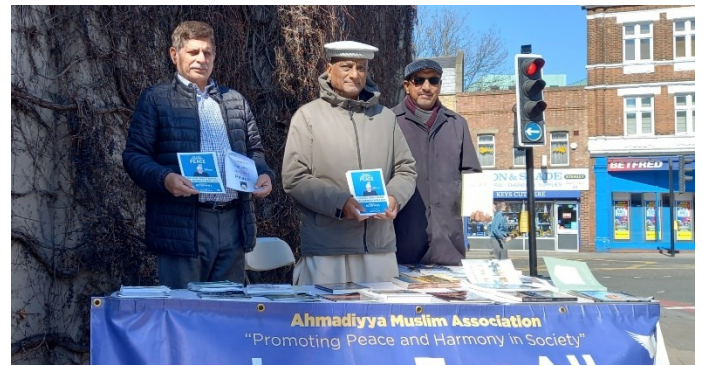
Majlis Fazal Mosque

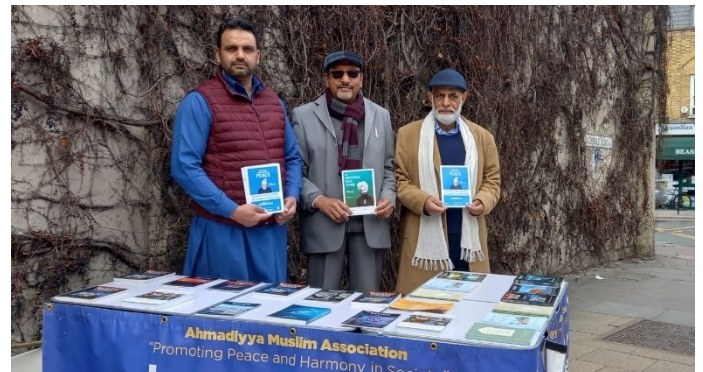
sahib and Jahangir Ahmad sahib. They distributed 108 leaflets and had 3 discussions.

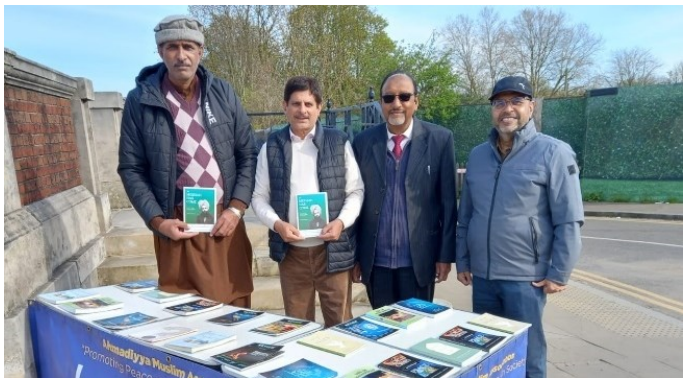

TABLIGH COMMITTEE MEETINGS

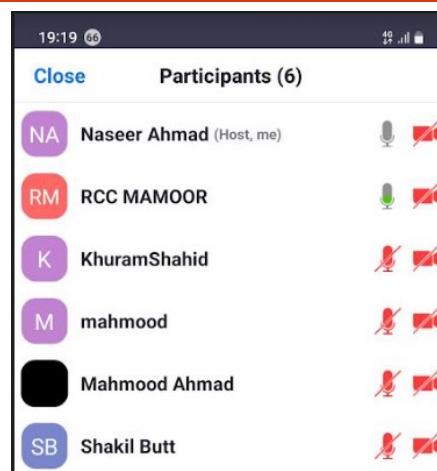
NASIR REGION

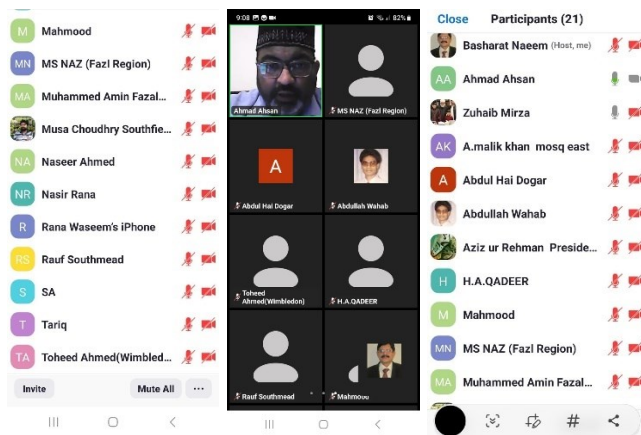
The class started with the recitation of the Holy Quran done by Dr Naseer Ahmad sahib.

NASIR REGION

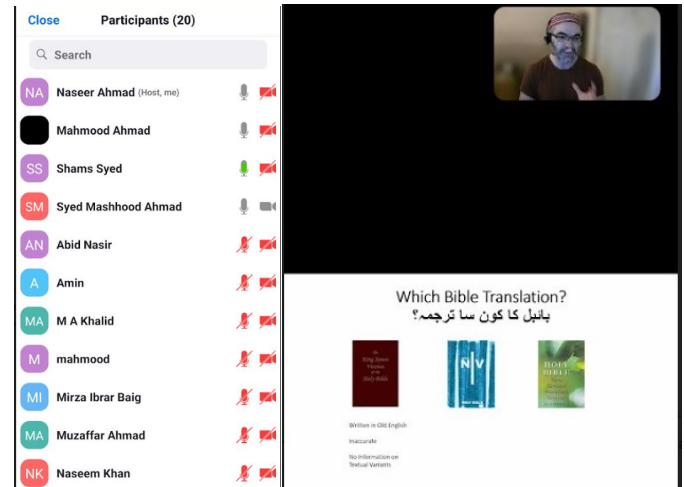

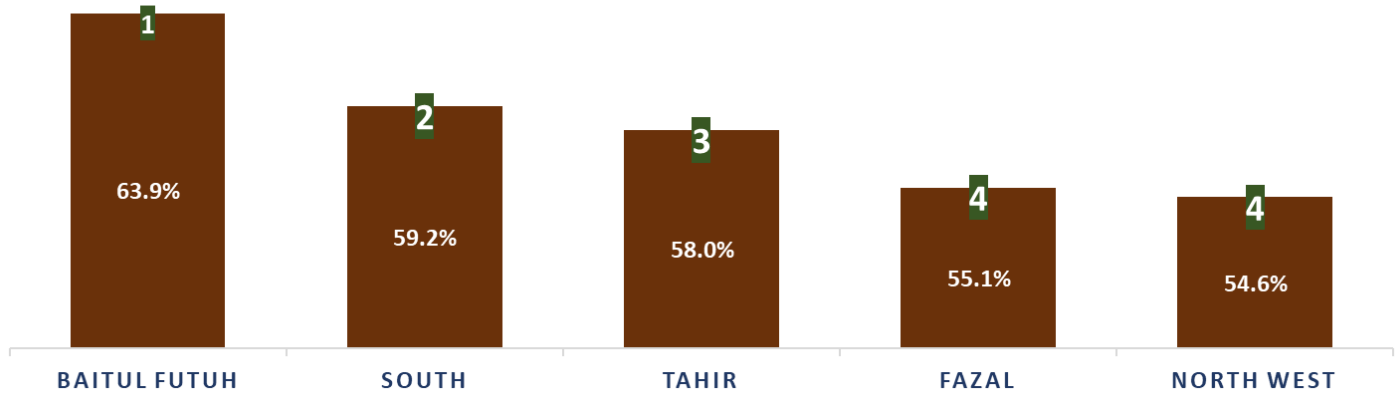

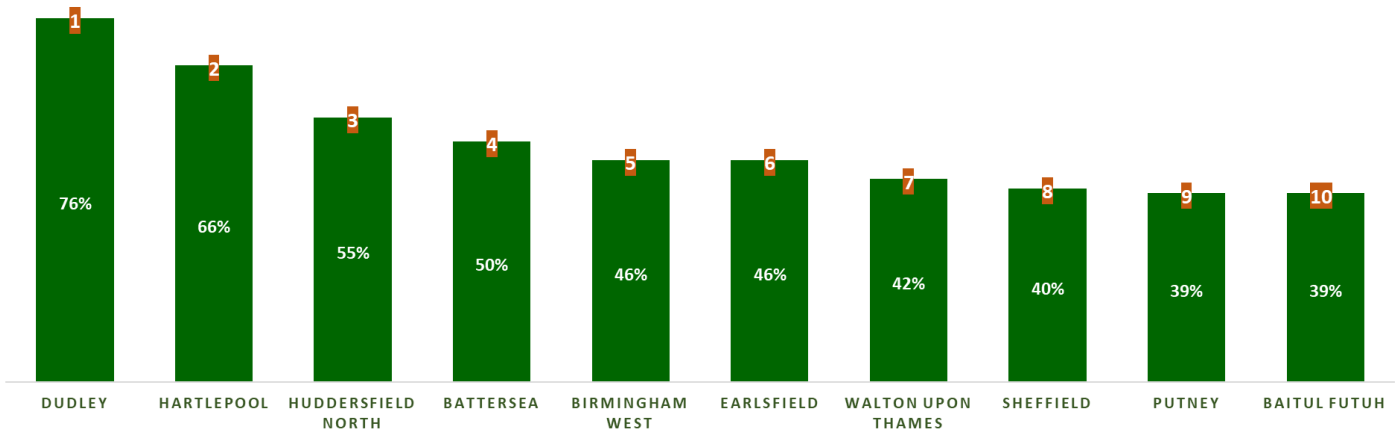

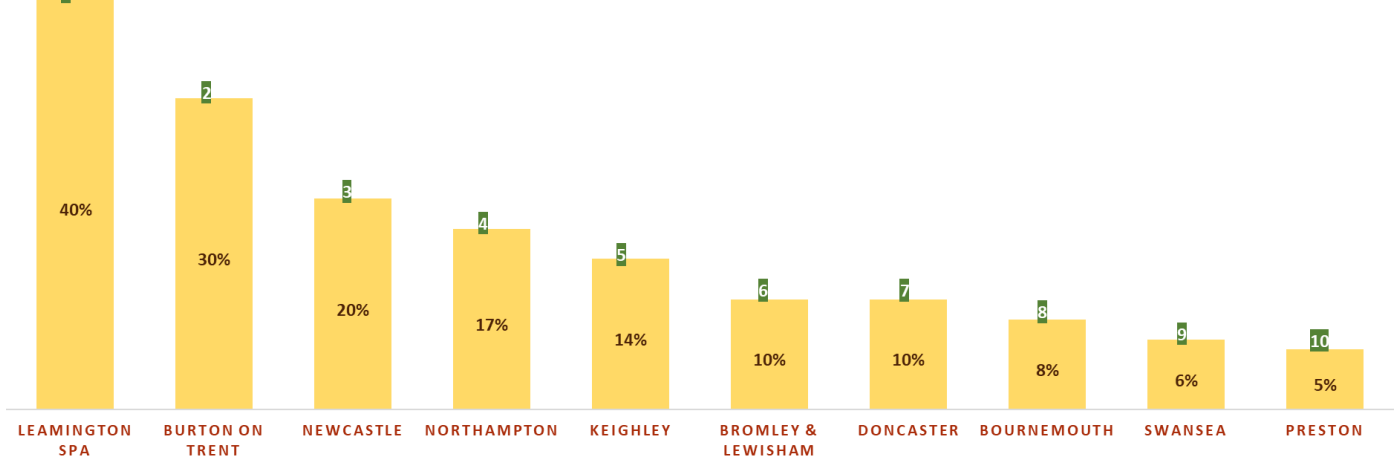
TOP 5 REGIONS IN MARCH 2023

INTRODUCTION OF AHMADIYYA MUSLIM ELDERS ASSOCIATION

Ahmadiyya Muslim Elders Association is an auxiliary organisation of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.

For more than one hundred years, the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community has been leading a peaceful revival of Islam. From the time it was founded in India in 1889, it has enjoyed an unrivalled record for peace and for its efforts to build cohesive societies.

A community that stands for education, integration and interfaith peace, we welcome all to visit our mosques as well as our numerous seminars and events that bring people together to understand more about each other.

The Ahmadiyya Muslim Elders Association works closely with charitable organisations and community groups to promote peace and provide volunteers and funds for the hundreds of organisations who are working towards humanitarian and environmental causes.

EID CELEBRATIONS

Muslims celebrate two festivals every year called **Eid-ul-Fitr** and **Eid-ul-Adha**.

Eid-ul-Fitr (A Thanksgiving Festival)

Eid-ul-Fitr is a festival that marks the end of the Holy month of Ramadhan. This joyous day is celebrated to give thanks for the blessings of Ramadhan.

During Eid-ul-Fitr, Muslims:

- Offer **Congregational Eid prayer** in the morning and extend greetings to each other.
- Help the needy in the form of Fitrana, Eid Fund and Sadqa (charity).
- Wear new clothing, cook delicious food and invite friends, poor and neighbours to celebrate with them.
- Prostrate to Allah asking for steadfastness on good habits and deeds learned during Ramadan.

Eid-ul-Adha (Festival of Sacrifice)

Eid-ul-Adha is a festival which marks the completion of Hajj (Holy pilgrimage to Mecca) on the tenth day of the

Islamic month Zul Haj. It commemorates the obedience of Hazrat Ibrahim and his son Hazrat Ismail to the commandment of Allah. Hazrat Ibrahim had a series of dreams in which he saw himself sacrificing his eldest son Ismail.

What Muslims Do:

- Offer congregational Eid prayer service in the morning and greet each other.
- Sacrifice animal such as goat, lamb, cow or camel and distribute meat to families, friends and the poor. The act of sacrifice is a symbolic reminding to the person who offers it that as the animal is inferior to him so he, also, is inferior to God and should, therefore, be ready to sacrifice himself and all his personal interests and inclinations for the sake of God when he is required to do so. The attainment of righteousness should be the goal of every Muslim.
- Where possible, we also offer charity to help poor.

 - Photo should be natural, eye catching
- Even sending news for radio, photo can be of great help for news editor to visualise the news and is a great way of impressing their human side.
