120 years old prophecy about Kabul



Hazrat Sahibzada Abdul Latif^(ra) was one of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community's first martyrs. He was born in Syedgah, Afghanistan, to a well-known family. People from all over Afghanistan visited him to benefit from his spirituality and knowledge. Upon receiving a book of the Promised Messiah, Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad^(as), Hazrat Sahibzada^(ra) said, "This is surely the individual for which the world was waiting. He is truly a messenger of God and has come to guide people back to the right path."

Accepting Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad^(as) as the Promised Messiah placed him at odds with prevailing religious leaders and the Amir of

Afghanistan, who later ordered his execution. Even in the face of extreme opposition, he displayed unflinching courage.

On his martyrdom, Promised Messiah^(as) expressed his grief in the following words:

O' Abdul Lateef, may you be blessed thousands of times as you proved your sincerity in my lifetime... This was a most merciless killing that has no match in this age. What folly has this Amir committed that he has ruined himself by his merciless killing of such an innocent person. O land of Afghanistan, bears witness that a grave offence has been committed in thee. O, unfortunate land thou has fallen in the estimation of God in that this great tragedy was enacted in thee.

As foretold by Hazrat Ahmad, peace be on him, in the above prophecy, the entire family of Amir Habibullah Khan was wiped out because of this barbaric crime. The Amir himself and his brother Nasrullah Khan were both assassinated, later on his family was forced to go into exile. The day after the stoning, a severe epidemic of cholera broke out in Kabul that killed thousands of citizens including close relatives of the Amir. The country has been in turmoil ever since Hazrat Sahibzada sahib was martyred.

WEST MIDLANDS

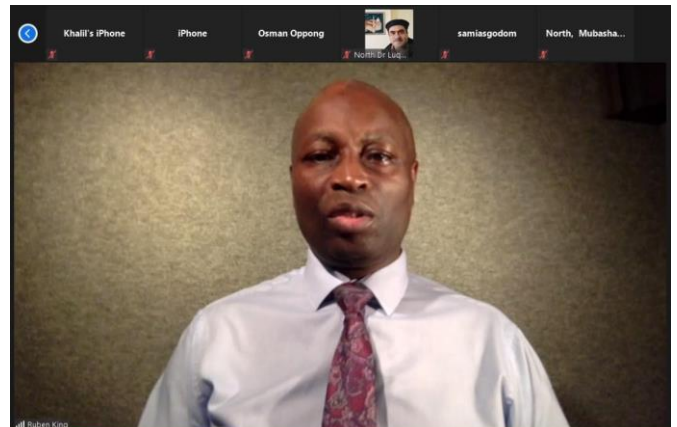
Majlis Ansarullah West Midlands held Regional Virtual Mosque Open Day was on 4th July 2021.

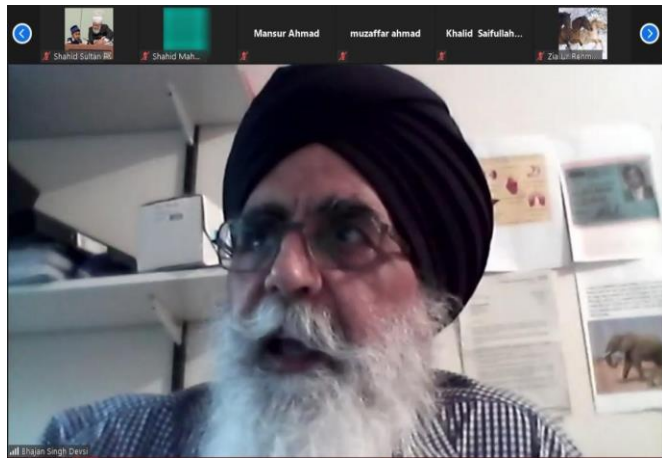

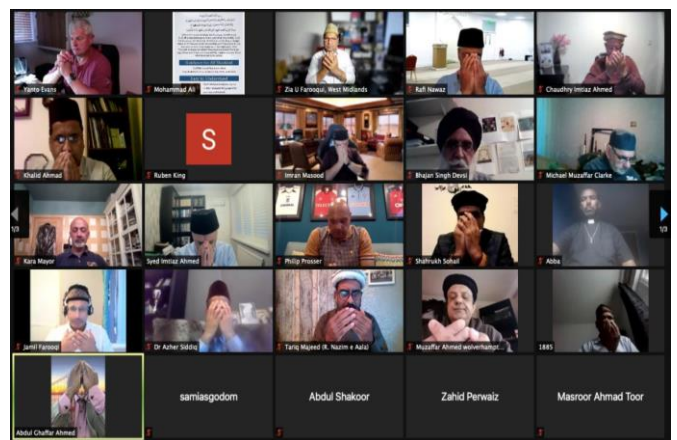
Several other guests including Bishop Ruben King serving as the Lead Pastor for New Testament Church of God, Reverend Sami Asgodom, Bhagan

A total of 57 “Messiah Has Come” leaflets were distributed at these stalls. Ansār participation were as follows:

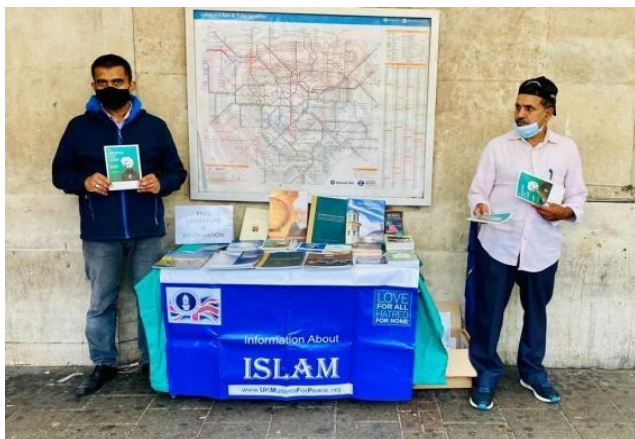

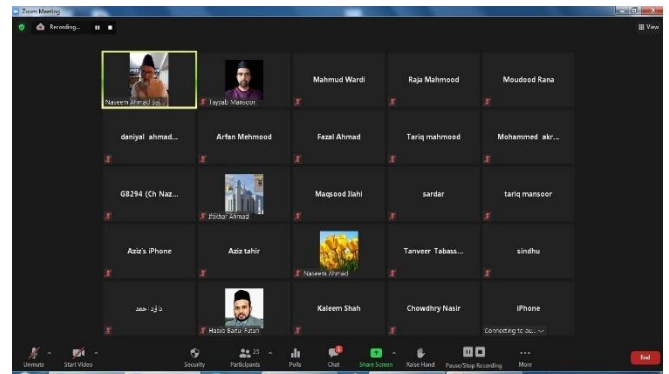




DA'ĪĀN ILALLAH CLASS

BAITUL FUTUH REGION

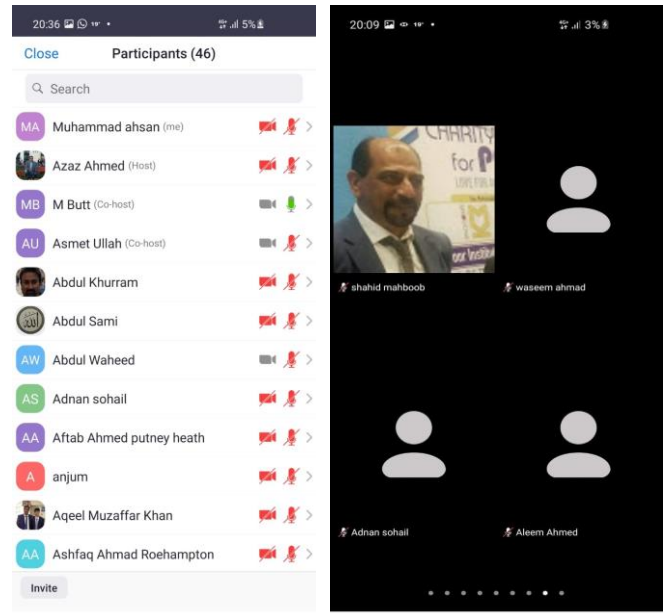

He covered the topic of Jihad and Terrorism. Imam sahib spoke in detail about this subject in light of the Qur'ānic teachings and gave answers how to tackle this age's issues related to defame Islam.

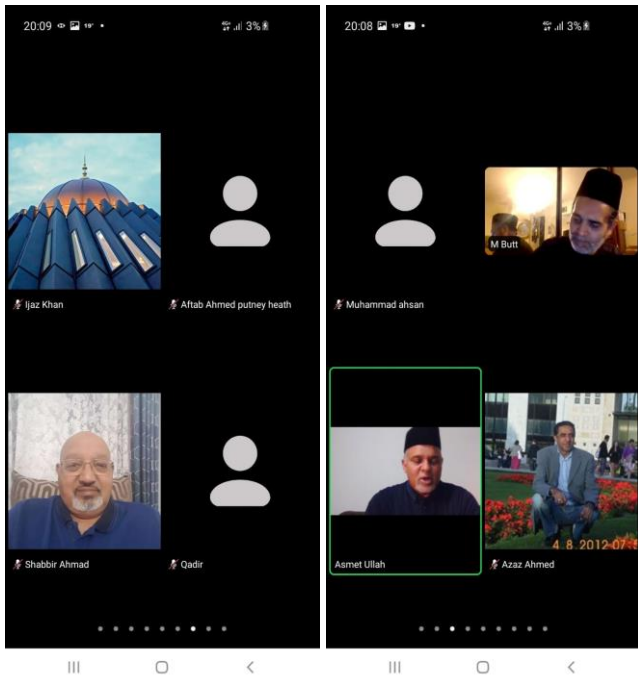

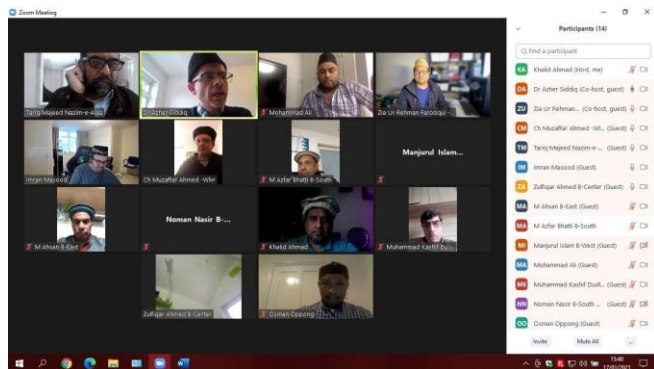

- 1 to1 Tabligh in Majālis

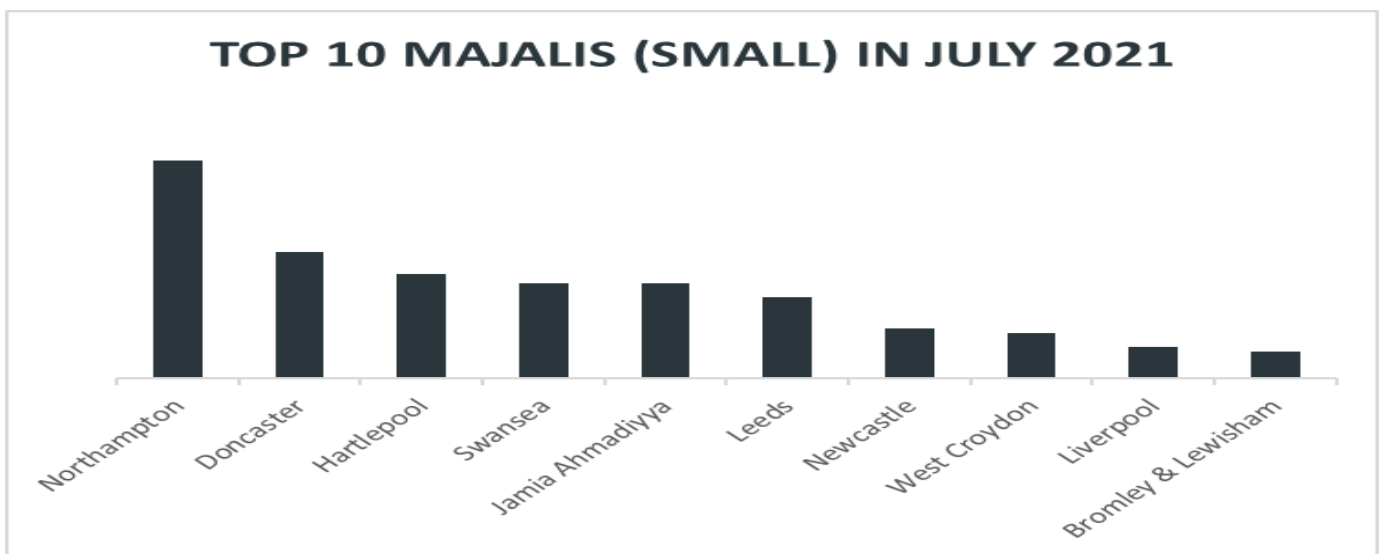
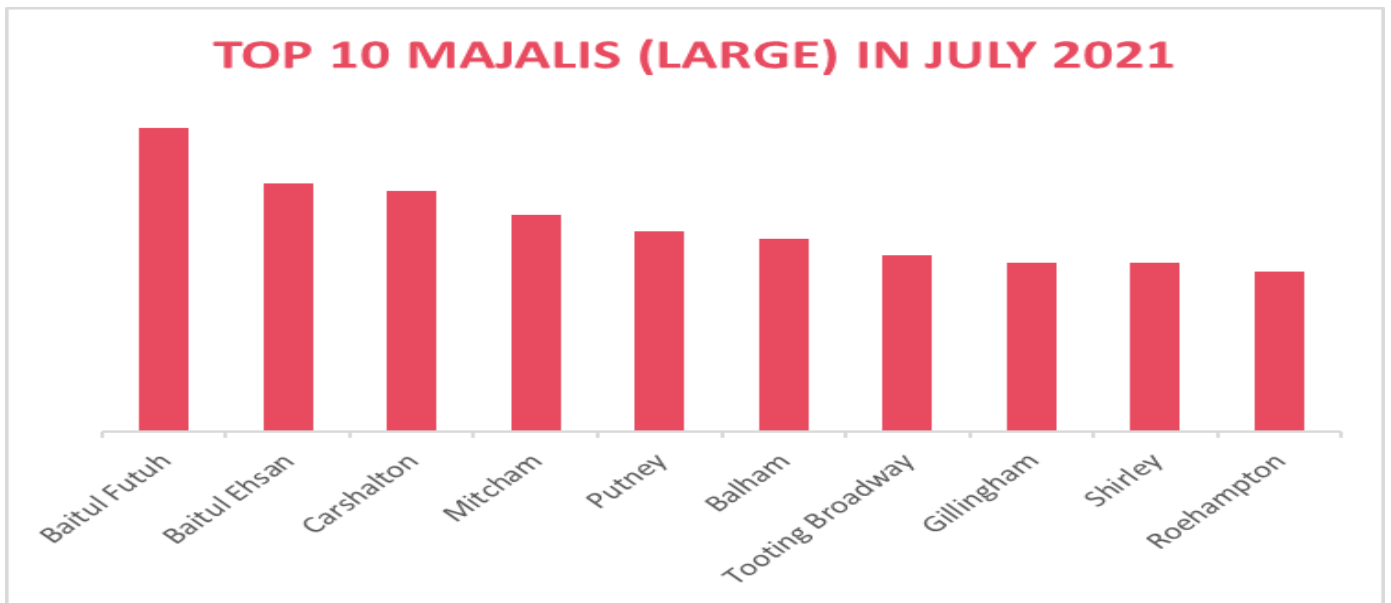
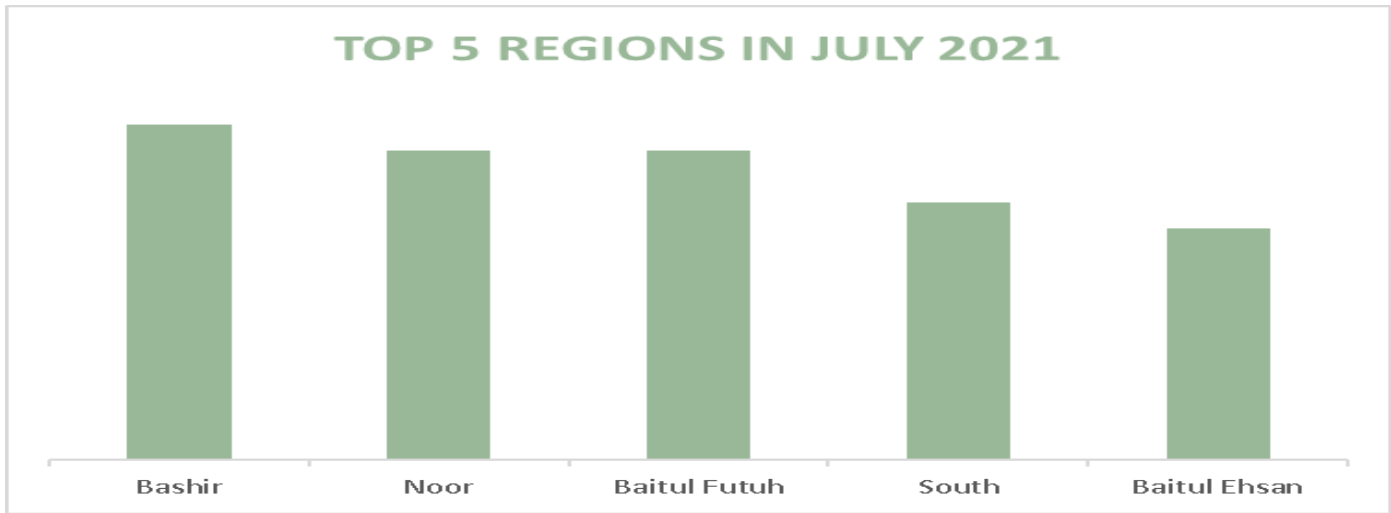


BAITUL FUTUH REGION
