

ASHRAH TABLĪGH MAJLIS ANSARULLAH UK



Qiādat Tablīgh, Majlis Ansarullah the United Kingdom celebrated Ashrah Tablīgh on the Majlis level from Friday, 7th to Sunday, 16th October 2022.

For the success of this Ashrah Tablīgh, Qiādat Tablīgh gave targets to all the Nazmeen Tablīgh Region and guided them to achieve their targets. Qiādat Tablīgh provided all the necessary document templates like invitation letters etc. Majalis emphasised to held Tablīgh stalls and Peace Forums in villages. Following is a summary of the efforts made during this Ashrah Tablīgh.

Letter to Huzoor Anwar (aba):

Based on the reports received from 105 Majlis during this Ashrah Tablīgh, more than 505 Ansar wrote letters for achieving bai'at and success of

Ashrah Tablīgh to his holiness Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V ل بروالله تعالى بتصروالعزيز.

Village Tablīgh Stall:

There was a big drive in Majalis to hold Tablīgh stalls in their assigned villages and establish good contacts. During this Ashrah Tablīgh, 65 Majalis made 165 contacts with various organisations, councils, educational institutions, and churches in their assigned villages. 86 Majalis set up Tablīgh stall, and they had the opportunity to hold 173 Tablīgh stalls in total. Majalis also held city Tablīgh stalls during this Ashrah and distributed 15,694 "Stop WW3" leaflets and 2,783 other leaflets and books. With these stalls, Majalis got many good contacts.

Peace Forum:

During this Ashrah Tablīgh, 26 Majalis organised Peace Forum in villages. For the success of these Peace Forums, Majalis visited their assigned villages, set up Tablīgh stalls, and gave leaflets and 8,660 printed invitations from door to door. In these Peace Forums, 447 Ansar and about 200 non-Muslim/non-Ahmadi participated. In these Peace Forums, the Majalis gave the Ahmadiyya Jamaat's message of peace.

Majalis got an opportunity to initialise a dialogue between different religions on world crises and establish peace in the world and how we can work together. Majalis also established new and good contacts.

On these Peace Forums, Majalis set up Quran Exhibitions and Tablīgh stalls. Majalis got the opportunity to distribute copies of the Holy Quran and Jamaat literature to the attendees.

Question and answer sessions were also a part of these sessions that clarified the position of Ahmadiyya Jamaat to non-Muslims and non-Ahmadi in various matters. Guests highly appreciated these Peace Forums. In some Peace Forums, Majalis gifted the Holy Quran and literature to the guest speakers. These events also got good coverage in local media and newspapers. Regions tweeted from their Twitter accounts to promote the Peace Forum organised by the Majlis.

Social Media:

According to regional reports, 576 Ansar participated in the Twitter campaign during this Ashrah Tablīgh. Twitter Space was organised on 9th October 2022 by the Qiādat Tablīgh of Majlis Ansarullah UK. Regions who tweeted their events during this Ashrah Tablīgh from their Twitter account were 11, and Ansar that took part were 262. The Majalis and Ansar also supported promoting these events through their social media accounts.







Mr Tariq Malik (Regional Coordinator) for Charity Walk for Peace introduced the excellent work done by Jamaat Ahmadiyya for charity. He invited the audience to join forces and help each other towards the same cause of promoting peace. He said that Charity Walk for Peace has raised 7.1 million pounds for UK charities till now and has supported over 600 charities without deducting any administrative costs. He thanked the volunteers as an integral part of the charity, without whom they could not have made this impact.

Revd Kim Topham, Assistant Curate for St Leonards, St Saviours, and St John's addressed the audience by quoting the beautiful teachings of Jesus from the Bible, "Love your neighbour", and praised AMEA for holding such events. She added that today she has learned the similarities between two beautiful teachings and looks forward towards working together for the betterment of the community.

The keynote speech was delivered by Imam Imran Ahmad Khalid sahib (Missionary In charge at Baitul Ghafoor Mosque Long Lane). He described the importance of establishing peace in society and globally, quoting the verses from the Holy Quran and the teachings of the founder of Islam, Prophet Mohammad(saw). He cited, "And if two parties of believers fight against each other, make peace between them; then if after that one of them transgresses against the other, fight the party that transgresses until it returns to the command of Allah. Then if it returns, make peace between them with equity, and act justly. Verily, Allah loves the just. (Ch. 49: v.10)."

He further said that though this teaching is about Muslims, yet by adhering to this principle, the foundation of peace on a worldwide basis can be laid. At the outset, it was explained that the

foremost requirement is justice to maintain peace in society. And, despite abiding by the principle of justice, if efforts to make peace are unsuccessful, then unite and fight collectively against the party that has transgressed and continue until such a time that the transgressing party is ready to make peace. Once the transgressing party is ready to make peace, justice requires not seeking revenge and not imposing restrictions or embargoes. By all means, keep an eye on the transgressor while trying to improve his situation.



The supreme head of the worldwide Ahmadiyya Muslim Community, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, expressed his concerns earlier this year in March 2022 in the following words:

"Most regrettably, it is this never-ending craving for power and wealth, whether on the part of Russia, the Western world or other major powers, which has led mankind down such a dangerous path that threatens to shatter the peace of the world."

His Holiness had further said:

"A dark and ominous shadow has been cast upon much of the world, and if, God forbid, the current situation escalates further, the consequences do not bear thinking about."

Guests were served refreshments and food.

In his speech, Imam Imran explained the need to foster peace in society regarding chapter 49:10 of the Holy Quran and the teachings of Prophet Mohammad (PBUH).

"And if two parties of believers fight against each other, make peace between them; then if after that one of them transgresses against the other, fight the party that transgresses until it returns to the command of Allah. Then if it returns, make peace between them with equity, and act justly. Verily, Allah loves the just. (Ch. 49: v.10)."

He said that global peace could be achieved if the world could adhere to this Islamic principle. According to him, justice is an important requirement for world peace. There is a need for




NUMBER OF POSTS/TWEETS (Jul-Sep 2022)





TABLĪGH PLAN – NOVEMBER 2022

Tablīgh Committee Meetings

- All Regions and Majālis are requested to conduct Tablīgh Committee Meeting in the first week of the month to discuss and implement November Tablīgh Plan
- One of the Qiādat Tablīgh team members to attend regional meetings and region to attend Local Tablīgh Committee Meetings

Village Visit

• Majālis are requested to make at least **one visit** to their allocated village this month to establish contacts with village charities, council, schools, churches, other faiths or similar village-based organisations

Tabligh Stalls

- Majālis are requested to hold at least 1 City Tablīgh Stall and 2 Village Tablīgh Stalls
- The quality of these stalls should be of high standards **Tabligh Stalls Guidelines**

Gift of the Holy Qur'an

- Gift a copy of the Holy Qur'ān (Arabic text with English translation & short commentary) to schools, colleges, universities, councils, churches, libraries and politicians
- The target for this year is to gift at least 48 copies for large regions and 24 copies for small regions

Daʻīān ilAllah Class

- Set a date for Daʻīān Class in your region and send it to Qiādat Tablīgh. Regions can fix it on a particular date of the month (e.g., 3rd day of every month) or a set day (e.g., every first Tuesday of the month)
- Request a Murabbi Silsila to be a teacher for Daʻiān Class. Try to have same teacher for all your classes. For a region who cannot arrange a Murabbi, Jamāʻat scholar can be requested. If region cannot find a teacher, Nazim Tablīgh should contact Additional Qaid sahib Tablīgh
- Hold Regional Da'īān Class. The main topic of this class will be "Death of Jesus(as)"

1 to 1 Sittings

• Every Nāsir to hold individual sittings with their Tablīgh contact (neighbours, friends, colleagues etc)

Peace Forum

- Every Majlis should organise at least one Peace Forum in their allocated village in a year
- Those Majālis who were not able to organise it last month, should hold a Peace Forum this month

Interfaith Week

- Inter Faith Week 2022 will take place from Sunday 13 Sunday 20 November
- This week should be used to organise any Peace Forum during this week to invite other faith-based organisations
